

## **The Exam**

The exam will cover a range of topics from the Expo 3 textbook.

### **Speaking** (approximately 5 minutes)

The speaking test will take place during normal lesson time. The boys will be asked about their childhood and how they are different now, testing their usage of the imperfect and present tenses. The following questions can be used to practise, but will serve as a launchpad into a broader conversation. Marks will be awarded for opinions, accuracy and extra detail, both for the questions below and the subsequent spontaneous conversation:

Qu'est-ce que tu portais pour aller à l'école?

Est-ce que tu avais un jouet spécial?

Qu'est-ce que tu regardais à la télé?

Qu'est-ce que tu faisais le week-end?

Quand j'étais petit...

Tu as les cheveux comment?

Qu'est-ce que tu portes pour aller à l'école?

Est-ce que tu as un jouet spécial?

Qu'est-ce que tu regardes à la télé?

Qu'est-ce que tu fais le week-end?

Quelle sorte d'enfant es-tu?

### **Listening** (approximately 20 minutes)

There will be several short texts to listen to in French. Answers will be in the form of tick boxes or writing the correct letter. No extended answers in either English or French will be required.

### **Reading and Writing** (45 minutes)

The Reading Section will comprise three reading comprehension questions.

The Writing Section will involve answering questions about hobbies, eating and drinking, sport and exercise and staying healthy. One to two sentences will be required for each bullet point, across the present, perfect and future tenses.

### **Grammar** (30 minutes)

The Grammar Section will comprise questions on the Present, Perfect, Imperfect and future tenses. **You will need to look up and learn the verbs as listed in the other PDF document.**

**The following topics in particular should be revised for the grammar section:**

- The Present Tense of the irregular verbs 'aller', 'avoir', 'faire' and 'être' (Page 147)
- The Present Tense (Page 133)
- The Perfect Tense (Page 134)
- The Imperfect Tense (Page 135)
- The Future Tense (Page 137)
- Possessive pronouns (Page 132)

**The following topic should be revised for the reading section:**

- Talking about what you used to do when you were younger (Pages 60 and 61)
